HB 2649

Increases tax rates for individuals with taxable income above \$125,000 for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2009.

Establishes increased tax rate for individuals with taxable income above \$250,000 for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2009, and before January 1, 2012. Decreases tax rate for individuals with taxable income above \$125,000 for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2012.

Phases out subtraction for federal income taxes paid for taxpayer with federal adjusted gross income of \$125,000 or more for individual return and \$250,000 or more for joint return. Eliminates subtraction for taxpayer with adjusted gross income of \$145,000 or more for individual return and \$290,000 or more for joint return. Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2009.

Exempts first \$2,400 in unemployment compensation from Oregon personal income tax for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2009, and before January 1, 2010.

Directs Department of Revenue to waive penalty or interest for taxpayer who underpays or underreports as result of changes to tax law in Act. Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2009, and before January 1, 2010.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

- Initial any changes that you or the circulator makes to your printed name, residence address or date on which you signed the petition.
- It is advisable to use a pen for signing petitions.
- It is unlawful to sign any person's name other than your own. Do not sign another person's name under any circumstances.
- It is unlawful to sign a petition more than once.
- It is unlawful for a person to knowingly sign a petition when the person is not qualified to sign it.
